Rhône-inspired, the 2022 Painted Fields Sierra Cotes is blend of 40% Syrah, 30% Grenache, and 30% Mourvèdre, some of the grapes coming from Starfield in nearby El Dorado County. Offering tremendous value, the acidity is balanced and helps freshen the medium-bodied weight and 14 months in 25% new French oak. Black cherry is the star, finding hints of mountain sage, lavender, and earthy mushroom. It's quite delicious. Enjoy through 2030.

Andis has a great hospitality space in the heart of Amador County and takes a lighter approach to its wines. Estate winemaker Mark Fowler works with Napa Valley-based winemakers Maayan Koschitzky and Philippe Melka to manage both the estate and source grapes from the wider area.
