REVIEW

The 2024 Semillon Bill Dillian Vineyard is a tart white high in acidity flecked in dried herb, wet stone, and grapefruit. From an own-rooted vineyard and entirely varietal, it spends 6-8 months in barrel, mostly used, with some lees stirring for texture and length. Medium-bodied, it delivers complexity and freshness, finishing in a hint of saline and citrus. Drink now through 2032.

Andis has a great hospitality space in the heart of Amador County and takes a lighter approach to its wines. Estate winemaker Mark Fowler works with Napa Valley-based winemakers Maayan Koschitzky and Philippe Melka to manage both the estate and source grapes from the wider area.
